






Coronavirus is making people poorly.




Staying apart from people helps keep everyone safe and healthy.

The rules help keep everyone safe and healthy.




## Here are some of the rules:

When we need to move around school, we will walk one way around the corridor.




I will eat dinner in my classroom.

## Each 'bubble' will have some time outside.




We will only be with our friends in our 'bubble' on the playground.

## We will have our own area of the playground to play.




No hugs, shaking hands or high fives. I can say and sign 'hi', or wave.




I need to try to stay two metres apart from other people.

I need to catch coughs and sneezes with my elbow.




I need to put my tissues in the bin.



I need to wash my hands before I eat and after I go to the toilet.

Adults will remind me of other times I need to wash my hands.



I need to wash my hands with soap and water for 20 seconds.

This is as long as it takes to count to 20 slowly, or to sing Happy Birthday twice.



Before I come into school, I need to use hand sanitiser.

This cleans my hands.



I might need to use hand sanitiser at other times too: adults will tell me when.
